Hi – I'm going to tell you all about this research study.

First, can I ask a question?
What is a research study?



It's okay to ask questions! A research study is one way scientists try to find answers to their questions.

We are asking you and your family to be in this research study.



Me? Why do I get to be in a research study?

You get to be in this research study because we are trying to get information to help scientists find out more about autism. You can help us do that by being in our study.

It's OK to say "no" if you don't want to be in the study. You can also stop being in this study at any time.



It's okay if you say "no." You can still come see me.

What happens if I say "no"?



You can still go to your doctor if you say "no" to being in this study or if you decide to stop being in this study.



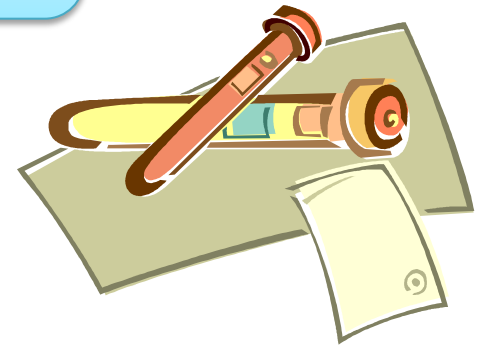
Why should I do it?

This study might not help you, but scientists hope to learn something that could help other children and teens in the future.

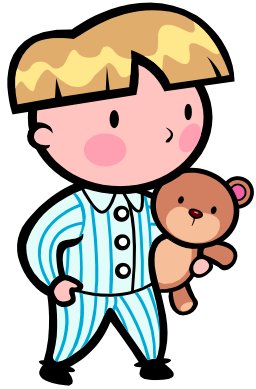


What will happen in this study?
What will I need to do if I say
“yes”?

A few weeks from now, your mom
or dad will take you to a clinic
where they will take a small amount
of your blood from your arm.

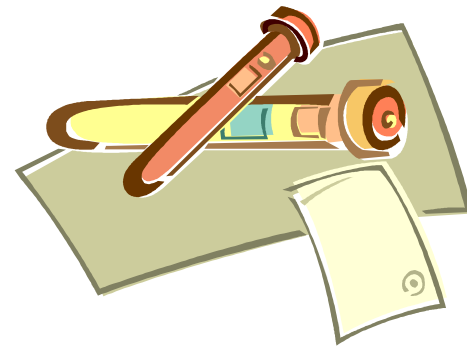


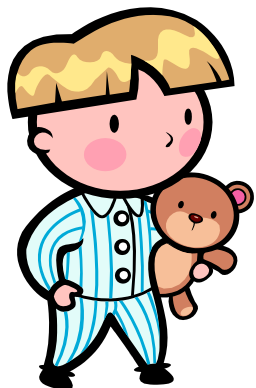
A small amount of your blood will go
from your arm into the tubes.



If I decide to say yes, will it hurt?

It might hurt a little. It could feel like a small pinch on your arm. You probably had some blood taken from your arm at a doctor's office before.





If I decide to say yes, do I have to do anything else for this study?

No – that's it.



All we want you to do in this study is to give us one sample of your blood. After that, we will be looking at your medical information, but we won't ask you to do anything else.

Please think carefully about this study and decide if you want to join. Talk to your parents about the study.

Remember, you can change your mind about being in the study at any time and nobody will be angry with you. It is up to you whether or not you want to take part in this study.
