## Why is it important?

Your information will allow scientists to explore the causes, treatments, and prevention of ASD.

Kaiser Permanente members with ASD and both biological parents.


## What's involved?

It's easy. Just provide a small sample of blood or saliva from each member of the trio and complete short questionnaires. Your information will be "de-identified" so your names and personal information will be protected.
